



2016 VERY SPECIAL VINEYARD VALLEY VIEW ROAD SHIRAZ

Over the past decade, some special pockets of land have consistently stood out to our winemakers for their quality and individual character. Fruit from these vineyards was set aside, and made in small batches to highlight this character as single vineyard wines. The commitment of each grower is recognised with their signature on the label.

Our tightly held VSV - Very Special Vineyard - wines are only made in exceptional years when a single site delivers the ultimate harmony of varietal and region.

Wayne and Scott Grope's Ebenezer vineyard at 360 metres above sea level, holds the position of the highest and most northern in the Barossa Valley. The vineyard was planted in 2002 in shallow red brown earth, underlain by schist and shale. The elevation and cooler position of this site produce later ripening grapes allowing harvest to occur at optimum maturity.
