Baileys of Glenrowan is one of the pioneers of winemaking in North-East Victoria, producing its first vintage in 1870. Since this time Baileys has become renowned for consistently producing intensely flavoured, long-lived red wines and world class fortifieds.

The Baileys vineyard commenced conversion to organics in 2009, attaining full certification in 2011.

This release is the fourth fully grown and certified organic wine from Baileys, and underlines our strong commitment to organic farming, and producing wines that truly speak of the place in which they were grown.

Vintage Conditions

2015 was an ideal vintage in North-East Victoria with good spring rains, and mild, settled conditions through the ripening period. This has resulted in table wines of considerable fruit concentration.

Nose

Ripe red cherries and raspberries with a perfumed potpourri lift.

Palate

Medium bodied with a cascade of juicy red fruits, fine supple tannins and fresh acidity. Seasoned French oak adds attractive spice and texture through the finish.
