BALLEYS of GLENROWAN

2015 1920S BLOCK SHIRAZ

Baileys of Glenrowan is one of the pioneers of winemaking in North-East Victoria, producing its first vintage in 1870. Since this time, Glenrowan has become a world-renowned winemaking region. Baileys of Glenrowan continues to be recognised today as an acclaimed producer of full-flavoured red and luscious fortified wines.

The fruit for this wine was handpicked from a cherished single vineyard block of old vines planted in the 1920s. The small and intensely concentrated Shiraz grapes produce a rich and luscious wine displaying impressive flavour.

The colour is dark and the nose is brooding, readying you for wine of concentration and power. The palate is rich and packed with spice, dark fruits, plums and liquorice. The wine has structure to match the powerful fruit spectrum and extraordinary flavour. Enjoy now or can be carefully cellared until 2025.
Ideal conditions made for an even growing season, allowing this dryland vineyard to grow a good canopy and fully ripen a small but intensely flavoured crop.
Shiraz grapes sourced from our single vineyard Baileys' Bundarra vineyard.
Open fermented and basket pressed just as it would have been in Baileys' pioneering days. This traditional winemaking approach respects our past with an eye to the future. The wine was barrel aged in an even mix of new, one year old and seasoned oak barrels, and predominately 500 litre puncheons.
With concentrated and powerful flavours, this Shiraz complements slow cooked meats such as braised beef cheek or melting-in-the- mouth lamb shoulder.
