



BAILEYS *of* GLENROWAN

Richard Bailey, the founder of Baileys of Glenrowan, brought his family to Australia in the 1850s. The family moved to North Eastern Victoria in the 1860s and Varley Bailey, Richard's son, made the first Baileys wine in 1870. Since this time, the region has become world-renowned for its premium red and fortified wines. Baileys of Glenrowan continues to be recognised today as a world-class producer of full-flavoured red and luscious fortified wines.

Baileys of Glenrowan Founder Series Liqueur Muscat NV

The Baileys Founder Series Liqueur Muscat is blended from selected parcels of Glenrowan stock, with a dash of top quality Rutherglen fruit added for complexity. Caramel red in the glass, the Muscat features the classic varietal aromas of orange blossom, raisins, dried citrus peel and rose petals, developing on the palate into a luscious wine full of fruit flavours and a careful balance of sweetness, acid, oak and alcohol.

Viticulture

Baileys of Glenrowan has some of Victoria's oldest plantings of vines. After the devastation of phylloxera at the turn of the last century, the vines were replanted in the rich granite soil below the Warby Ranges. The Glenrowan region has long warm summers with very little rainfall, allowing fruit to develop intense flavours and high natural sugar levels.

Vinification

After crushing and fermentation, individual parcels of Muscat were aged in various sized barrels of old oak. Our winemaker blended this wine from a selection of newer and aged stock to produce this fine fortified wine.


Wonderful with rich fruit cake, plum pudding, chocolate or as the end to any meal.
